

Ganesha Deity on Dholkal Hill in Chhattisgarh is a mysterious shrine located atop a hill in the middle of a dense forest. Kings of Chindak Nagvanshi dynasty were instrumental in establishing this temple. The deity carved in the shape of a dholak, a musical instrument hence, the hill has been named dholkal. The deity depicts Ganesha seated in his typical lalitasana or playful and easygoing posture.

The Neminath temple is the largest temple of the group standing in a quadrangular court 195 x 130 feet. The temple was rebuilt completely by Sajjana, the governor of Saurashtra appointed by Jayasimha Siddharaja of Chaulukya dynasty, in 1129 CE.

There is an inscription on one of the pillars of the mandapa stating that it was repaired in 1278 CE

It was repeatedly damaged and plundered during wars, repeatedly rebuilt and repaired over its history. The enormous wealth, and vast pool of talented craftsmen, required to construct the matchless temple gave a message of the empire's tremendous power.





Arulmigu Meenakshi Sundareshwarar Temple is a historic Hindu temple located temple city of Madurai, Tamil Nadu, India. It is dedicated to the goddess Meenakshi, a form of Parvati, and her consort, Sundareshwar, a form of Shiva. The temple is at the centre of the ancient temple city of Madurai mentioned in the Tamil Sangam literature, with the goddess temple mentioned in 6th-century-CE texts. This temple is one of the Paadal Petra Sthalam. The Paadal Petra sthalam are 275 temples of lord Shiva that are revered in the verses of Tamil Saiva Nayanars of 6th-9th century CE.

Konark Sun Temple is a 13th-century CE (the year 1250) Sun temple at Konark. The temple is attributed to king Narasimhadeva I of the Eastern Ganga dynasty about 1250 CE. Dedicated to the Hindu Sun God Surya, what remains of the temple complex has the appearance of a 100-foot (30 m) high chariot with immense wheels and horses, all carved from stone.

Ranakpur temple is famous for its intricate carvings and unique architecture and was voted amongst the top 77 wonders of the world. The unique thing about the temple is its colour-changing columns. They go from golden to pale blue after every hour that passes during the day. Moreover, each of these columns has been carved intricately without repeating any designs. Hence, no two columns in the temple have similar designs. The two large bells in the prayer hall give a harmonious sound upon their movement and are like a cheerful song to the ears of the devotees.
